Dear Chairman and Commissioners:

We are writing to reiterate our support of the strong and enforceable net neutrality rules enshrined in the 2015 Open Internet Order.

Today, because of long standing respect for net neutrality codified in the 2015 Order, the internet contributes more than 6 percent of US GDP, over 3 million direct American jobs, and nearly 24 million additional Online Income Opportunities in every state. In fact, the free and open internet is critical for friends and family looking to connect, students using distance learning applications, and communities engaging with support groups. Net neutrality is not just a business issue.

The draft "Restoring Internet Freedom Order" under consideration by the FCC undoes decades of bipartisan agreement on net neutrality principles and ends net neutrality as we know it.
